This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into by and between EHREN BEIL, hereinafter, "BEIL" and the STATE OF OHIO COUNSELOR, SOCIAL WORKER, MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPIST BOARD, hereinafter "BOARD" the state agency charged with enforcing Chapter 4757 of the Ohio Revised Code and all rules promulgated therein.

BEIL hereby acknowledges that he has read and understands this CONSENT AGREEMENT and has voluntarily entered into it without threat or promise by the BOARD or any of its members, employees or agents. **BEIL** is fully aware of his rights, including his right to be advised by counsel and his right to a hearing pursuant to Chapter 119 of the Ohio Revised Code on the issues which are the subject of this CONSENT AGREEMENT.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT contains the entire agreement between the parties, there being no other agreement of any kind, verbal or otherwise, which varies the terms of this CONSENT AGREEMENT.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into on the basis of the following stipulations and, understandings:

- BEIL is a professional counselor (C-0007987) licensed to practice counseling in the State of Ohio, and is subject to the laws and rules of Ohio regulating the practice of counseling as outlined in Ohio Revised Code Section 4757 and Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 4757.
 BEIL received his counselor license on November 21, 2003.
- 2. The Board received information that from approximately August through October, 2012, **BEIL**, while employed at an agency in Warren, Ohio, entered into a sexual relationship with a recently terminated client. This action constitutes a violation of O.R.C. 4757.36 (C) (1), O.A.C 4757-5-04 (A).
- 3. **BEIL** admits to the allegations in paragraph 2.

Wherefore, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual promises hereinafter set forth, and in lieu of any other formal disciplinary proceedings, **BEIL** knowingly and voluntarily agrees with the **BOARD** to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. **BEIL'S** license to practice counseling is hereby **SUSPENDED** for two (2) years beginning July 20, 2013. **BEIL** must renew his license during the period of suspension if he intends to re-enter the field.
- 2. BEIL agrees to undergo a mental health assessment and to follow all recommendations of the assessment practitioner to engage in counseling, therapy and medical treatment, if any. The Board must receive the assessment report by September 20, 2013, from a BOARD pre-approved practitioner. All costs associated with this assessment are at BEIL'S expense. BEIL must submit the name, contact information, and professional resume or vitae to the BOARD'S Deputy Director no later than August 20, 2013, to obtain pre-approval. If the practitioner recommends counseling BEIL will follow any/all recommendations and, the practitioner will provide the BOARD with quarterly reports entailing issues discussed in counseling, professional ethics, boundaries and responsibilities, and other issues the practitioner deems appropriate. The first quarterly report will be due to the BOARD offices by November 20, 2013. At the completion of any/all recommended counseling, the practitioner shall provide the BOARD with a report encompassing the counseling including areas of improvement, areas of concern (if any) and if in the practitioner's pr ofessional opinion, BEIL is able to function properly as a professional counselor.

It is hereby agreed by and between both parties that this CONSENT AGREEMENT hereby settles all issues concerning this matter.

By his signature on this CONSENT AGREEMENT, **BEIL** acknowledges that in the event the **BOARD**, in its discretion, does not approve this CONSENT AGREEMENT, this settlement offer is withdrawn and shall be of no evidentiary value and shall not be relied upon or introduced in any disciplinary action or appeal by either party. **BEIL** agrees that should the **BOARD** reject this CONSENT AGREEMENT and if this case proceeds to hearing, he will assert no claim that the **BOARD** was prejudiced by its review and discussion of this CONSENT AGREEMENT or of any information relating thereto.

BEIL hereby releases the members of the **BOARD**, its officers and employees, jointly and severally, from any and all liability arising from the matter within.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT shall be considered a public record as that term is used in Section 149.43 of the Ohio Revised Code. Pursuant to 42 USC Section 132a-73(b), 5 USC Section 552a, 45 CFR part 61, and Ohio Revised Code 3123.41 et seq., the **BOARD** may be required to provide **BEIL'S** social security number to requesting governmental agencies.

The **BOARD** shall incorporate this CONSENT AGREEMENT into a formal journal Entry at its _______, 2013, meeting.
