**CONSENT AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
JULIE C. SADLER
AND THE
STATE OF OHIO COUNSELOR, SOCIAL WORKER, MARRIAGE AND

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into by and between Julie C. Sadler, hereinafter, "SADLER," and the STATE OF OHIO COUNSELOR, SOCIAL WORKER, MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPIST BOARD, hereinafter "BOARD," the state agency charged with enforcing Chapter 4757 of the Ohio Revised Code and all rules promulgated therein.

SADLER hereby acknowledges that she has read and understands this CONSENT AGREEMENT and has voluntarily entered into it without threat or promise by the BOARD or any of its members, employees or agents.

SADLER is fully aware of her rights, including her right to be advised by counsel and her right to a hearing pursuant to Chapter 119 of the Ohio Revised Code on the issues which are the subject of this CONSENT AGREEMENT. Should SADLER fail to comply with any provisions of this CONSENT AGREEMENT, SADLER knowingly waives her rights under ORC Chapter 119.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT contains the entire agreement between the parties, there being no other agreement of any kind, verbal or otherwise, which varies the terms of this CONSENT AGREEMENT.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into on the basis of the following stipulations, admissions and understandings:

1. SADLER is a professional clinical counselor (E-0004077) licensed to practice counseling in the State of Ohio, and is subject to the laws and rules of Ohio regulating the practice of counseling as outlined in Ohio Revised Code Chapter 4757 and Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 4757. SADLER received her professional clinical counselor license on September 19, 2003.
2. In 2004, SADLER was treating a client at an agency where she was employed in Marysville, Ohio. In late 2004, SADLER blurred her professional boundaries by entering into a personal relationship with the client that eventually included sexual intimacies. In August 2005, SADLER ended the relationship. Entering into a multiple relationship,

including a sexual relationship, constitutes violations of Ohio Revised Code Section 4757.36(A)(1) and Ohio Administrative Code Sections 4757-5-01(C)(1) and 4757-5-01(D)(2).

3. **SADLER** admits the allegations referenced in paragraph 2 above.

Wherefore, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual promises hereinafter set forth, and in lieu of any formal disciplinary proceedings, **SADLER** knowingly and voluntarily agrees with the **BOARD** to the following terms and conditions:

1. **SADLER'S** license to practice counseling is hereby **REPRIMANDED**.
2. **SADLER'S** license to practice counseling is **indefinitely suspended** for a minimum of 4 years beginning December 1, 2005.
3. **SADLER** must begin professional mental health treatment for 3 years from a provider pre-approved by the **BOARD'S** Deputy Director or his designee. The 3 years of therapy will not begin until the **BOARD** approves the mental health provider but must start no later than December 1, 2006. The mental health provider will provide the **BOARD** with a yearly report due on the anniversary of the provider's approval. The annual report will detail issues discussed in therapy, frequency of therapy, and gains made by **SADLER**. It is **SADLER'S** responsibility to ensure the **BOARD** receives the yearly reports. At the end of the suspension and before the suspension is lifted, **SADLER** must have a full psychological assessment completed by a **BOARD** approved mental health provider to be provided to the **BOARD**. The **BOARD** has final authority to lift the suspension. All costs associated with the mental health counseling and reports/evaluations are at **SADLER'S** expense.
4. After the **BOARD** lifts the suspension and **SADLER** re-enters the field of professional counseling, she must notify the **BOARD** with whom she will be working. **SADLER** must be supervised for 2 years by a supervisor pre-approved by the **BOARD'S** Deputy Director or his designee. Supervision must be a minimum of one-hour every two weeks and include discussions of professional relationships. The 2 years of mandated supervision will not begin until the supervisor is approved by the **BOARD**. The supervisor will provide the **BOARD** with written reports every 6 months detailing issues discussed in supervision, professional growth, and strengths/weaknesses noted. The first report is due 6 months from the approval of the supervisor by the **BOARD**. All costs of supervision, if any, are at the expense of **SADLER**.
5. In order for **SADLER** to be able to re-enter the field of professional counseling once the suspension is lifted, she will have had to maintain her license in a current status meaning that she must renew her license and take all required continuing education hours.

It is hereby agreed by and between both parties that this CONSENT AGREEMENT hereby settles all issues concerning this matter.

By her signature on this CONSENT AGREEMENT, SADLER acknowledges that in the event the BOARD, in its discretion, does not approve this CONSENT AGREEMENT, this settlement offer is withdrawn and shall be of no evidentiary value and shall not be relied upon or introduced in any disciplinary action or appeal by either party. SADLER agrees that should the BOARD reject this CONSENT AGREEMENT and if this case proceeds to hearing, she will assert no claim that the BOARD was prejudiced by its review and discussion of this CONSENT AGREEMENT or of any information relating thereto.

SADLER hereby releases the members of the BOARD, its officers and employees, jointly and severally, from any and all liability arising from the matter within.


This CONSENT AGREEMENT shall be considered a public record as that term is used in Section 149.43 of the Ohio Revised Code. Pursuant to 42 USC Section 132a-73(b), 5 USC Section 552a, 45 CFR part 61, and Ohio Revised Code Section 3123.41 et seq. the BOARD may be required to provide SADLER'S social security number to requesting governmental agencies.

The BOARD shall incorporate this CONSENT AGREEMENT into a formal journal entry at its November 18, 2005, meeting.


