

**CONSENT AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
LISA M. GOJANOVIC
AND THE
STATE OF OHIO COUNSELOR, SOCIAL WORKER AND MARRIAGE AND
FAMILY THERAPIST BOARD**

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into by and between LISA M. GOJANOVIC, hereinafter, "GOJANOVIC," and the STATE OF OHIO COUNSELOR, SOCIAL WORKER AND MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPIST BOARD, hereinafter "BOARD," the state agency charged with enforcing Chapter 4757 of the Ohio Revised Code and all rules promulgated therein.

GOJANOVIC hereby acknowledges that she has read and understands this CONSENT AGREEMENT and has voluntarily entered into it without threat or promise by the BOARD or any of its members, employees or agents.

GOJANOVIC is fully aware of her rights, including her right to be advised by counsel and her right to a hearing pursuant to Chapter 119 of the Ohio Revised Code on the issues which are the subject of this CONSENT AGREEMENT.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT contains the entire agreement between the parties, there being no other agreement of any kind, verbal or otherwise, which varies the terms of this CONSENT AGREEMENT.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into on the basis of the following stipulation, admission and understanding:

- 1 GOJANOVIC is a licensed professional clinical counselor (E.0004081) licensed in the State of Ohio, and is subject to the laws and rules of Ohio regulating the practice of counseling as outlined in Ohio Revised Code Chapter 4757 and Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 4757. GOJANOVIC received her clinical counselor license September 19, 2003.
- 2 GOJANOVIC, while employed at UnitedHealth Group, on or about December 11, 2015, resigned her position without reasonable notification and appropriate referral for continued services to her clients. This inappropriate conduct constitutes a violation of Ohio Revised Code Section 4757.36(C) (1) and Ohio Administrative Code Sections 4757—5-02 (E) (1).
- 3 On March 22, 2016, GOJANOVIC submitted an e-mail, in response to a letter sent from the board requesting an informal interview regarding an allegation received. In the e-mail GOJANOVIC requested to voluntarily surrender her license.
- 4 GOJANOVIC ADMITS the allegations referenced in paragraph 2 and 3 above.

Wherefore, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual promises hereinafter set forth, and in lieu of any other formal disciplinary proceedings, **GOJANOVIC** knowingly and voluntarily agrees with the **BOARD** to the following terms and conditions:

- 1 The **BOARD** will allow **GOJANOVIC** to permanently surrender her license. **GOJANOVIC** will not be allowed to reapply for a counselor license in the State of Ohio, nor will she be allowed to apply for a social work or marriage and family therapist license in the State of Ohio. This surrender will take effect May 20, 2016.

hereby agreed by and between both parties that this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** hereby settles all issues concerning this matter.

By her signature on this **CONSENT AGREEMENT**, **GOJANOVIC** acknowledges that in the event the **BOARD**, in its discretion, does not approve this **CONSENT AGREEMENT**, this settlement offer is withdrawn and shall be of no evidentiary value and shall not be relied upon or introduced in any disciplinary action or appeal by either party. **GOJANOVIC** agrees that should the **BOARD** reject this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** and if this case proceeds to hearing, she will assert no claim that the **BOARD** was prejudiced by its review and discussion of this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** or of any information relating thereto. Should the licensee fail to comply with any provisions of this consent agreement, the Board in its discretion, may initiate further disciplinary action pursuant to OAC 4757-11-01C (21).

GOJANOVIC hereby releases the members of the **BOARD**, its officers and employees, jointly and severally, from any and all liability arising from the matter within. This **CONSENT AGREEMENT** shall be considered a public record as that term is used in Section 149.43 of the Ohio Revised Code. All parties to this Consent Agreement understand that this information will be sent to the United States Department of Health and Human Services' National Practitioner Data Bank 9NPDB0, pursuant to Title IV of Public Law 99-660, the Healthcare Quality Improvement Act of 1986, as amended; Section 1921 of the Social Security Act; and Section 1128E of the Social Security Act, as amended by Section 221(a) of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996. Pursuant to 42 USC Section 132a-73(b), 5 USC Section 552a, 45 CFR part 61 and Ohio Revised Code Section 2301.373(E), the **BOARD** may be required to provide **GOJANOVIC'S** social security number to requesting governmental agencies.

The **BOARD** shall incorporate this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** into a formal journal entry at its May 20, 2016 meeting.

This **CONSENT AGREEMENT** shall take effect upon the date of the last signature below:
