**CONSENT AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
DANIEL LIBSTORFF
AND THE
STATE OF OHIO COUNSELOR, SOCIAL WORKER, MARRIAGE AND
FAMILY THERAPIST BOARD**

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into by and between **DANIEL LIBSTORFF**, hereinafter, "**LIBSTORFF**", and the **STATE OF OHIO COUNSELOR, SOCIAL WORKER, MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPIST BOARD**, hereinafter "**BOARD**", the state agency charged with enforcing Chapter 4757 of the Ohio Revised Code and all rules promulgated therein.

LIBSTORFF hereby acknowledges that he has read and understands this CONSENT AGREEMENT and has voluntarily entered into it without threat or promise by the **BOARD** or any of its members, employees or agents.

LIBSTORFF is fully aware of his rights, including his right to be advised by counsel and his right to a hearing pursuant to Chapter 119 of the Ohio Revised Code on the issues which are the subject of this CONSENT AGREEMENT. Should **LIBSTORFF** fail to comply with any provisions of this CONSENT AGREEMENT, **LIBSTORFF** knowingly waives his rights under ORC Chapter 119.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT contains the entire agreement between the parties, there being no other agreement of any kind, verbal or otherwise, which varies the terms of this CONSENT AGREEMENT.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into on the basis of the following stipulations, admissions and understandings:

1. **LIBSTORFF** (E-0004149) is licensed to practice clinical counseling in the State of Ohio, and is subject to the laws and rules of Ohio regulating the practice of clinical counseling as outlined in Ohio Revised Code Chapter 4757 and Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 4757. **LIBSTORFF** received his clinical counselor license January 16, 2004.
2. **LIBSTORFF** failed to keep accurate records, entering them into client files a significant amount of time after the services were performed while employed at Concern Services, in Cincinnati, Ohio. Inaccurate record keeping is a violation of Ohio Revised Code Section 4757.36(A) (1) and Ohio Administrative Code Section 4757-5-01 (I) (2).
3. **LIBSTORFF ADMITS** the allegation referenced in paragraphs 2 above.

Wherefore, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual promises hereinafter set forth, and in lieu of any formal disciplinary proceedings, **LIBSTORFF** knowingly and voluntarily agrees with the **BOARD** to the following terms and conditions:

LIBSTORFF must take 6 hours of continuing education in ethics. The continuing education must be pre-approved by the Board. Online coursework will not meet this requirement. Once **LIBSTORFF** successfully completes the ethics training, **LIBSTORFF** must ensure verification of completion is sent to the attention of the Investigation Unit at the Board office. Verification of completion is due in the Board office no later than July 15, 2007. The hours earned from the continuing education may not be used toward the thirty (30) hours of continuing education required for license renewal. All costs associated with the course are at the expense of **LIBSTORFF**.

It is hereby agreed by and between both parties that this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** hereby settles all issues concerning this matter.

By his signature on this **CONSENT AGREEMENT**, **LIBSTORFF** acknowledges that in the event the **BOARD**, in its discretion, does not approve this **CONSENT AGREEMENT**, this settlement offer is withdrawn and shall be of no evidentiary value and shall not be relied upon or introduced in any disciplinary action or appeal by either party. **LIBSTORFF** agrees that should the **BOARD** reject this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** and if this case proceeds to hearing, he will assert no claim that the **BOARD** was prejudiced by its review and discussion of this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** or of any information relating thereto.

LIBSTORFF hereby releases the members of the **BOARD**, its officers and employees, jointly and severally, from any and all liability arising from the matter within.

This **CONSENT AGREEMENT** shall be considered a public record as that term is used in Section 149.43 of the Ohio Revised Code. Pursuant to 42 USC Section 132a-73(b), 5 USC Section 552a, 45 CFR part 61, and Ohio Revised Code 3123.41 et seq., the **BOARD** may be required to provide **LIBSTORFF'S** social security number to requesting governmental agencies.

The **BOARD** shall incorporate this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** into a formal journal entry at its Sept 22, 2006, meeting.


