**CONSENT AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN  
JENNIFER SLATER  
AND THE  
STATE OF OHIO COUNSELOR, SOCIAL WORKER, MARRIAGE AND  
FAMILY THERAPIST BOARD**

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into by and between JENNIFER L. SLATER, hereinafter, "SLATER," and the STATE OF OHIO COUNSELOR, SOCIAL WORKER, MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPIST BOARD, hereinafter "BOARD," the state agency charged with enforcing Chapter 4757 of the Ohio Revised Code and all rules promulgated therein.

SLATER hereby acknowledges that she has read and understands this CONSENT AGREEMENT and has voluntarily entered into it without threat or promise by the BOARD or any of its members, employees or agents.

SLATER is fully aware of her rights, including her right to be advised by counsel and her right to a hearing pursuant to Chapter 119 of the Ohio Revised Code on the issues which are the subject of this CONSENT AGREEMENT. Should SLATER fail to comply with any provisions of this CONSENT AGREEMENT, SLATER knowingly waives her rights under ORC Chapter 119.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT contains the entire agreement between the parties, there being no other agreement of any kind, verbal or otherwise, which varies the terms of this CONSENT AGREEMENT.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into on the basis of the following stipulations, admissions and understandings:

1. SLATER is a social worker (S-0001381) licensed to practice social work in the State of Ohio, and is subject to the laws and rules of Ohio regulating the practice of social work as outlined in Ohio Revised Code Chapter 4757 and Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 4757. SLATER received her social work license on March 14, 1987.
2. On August 3, 2006, SLATER was convicted in the Court of Common Pleas in Ashland County, Ohio of Improperly Furnishing Firearms to a minor, a felony of the fifth degree, in violation of ORC Section 2923.21(A)(3). SLATER'S actions constitute a violation of Ohio Revised Code Section 4757.36(A)(5).

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3. **SLATER ADMITS** the allegations referenced in paragraphs 2 above.

Wherefore, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual promises hereinafter set forth, and in lieu of any formal disciplinary proceedings, **SLATER** knowingly and voluntarily agrees with the **BOARD** to the following terms and conditions:

1. **SLATER** must attend a mandatory 12-Step program at least monthly until April 30, 2008. **SLATER** must notify the Board's investigation unit of the name of the 12-Step program she will be attending within 2 weeks of the approval of this Consent Agreement. **SLATER** must have the leader of the 12-STEP program send in a quarterly statement to the Board's investigation unit verifying her attendance at least monthly.
2. **SLATER** must receive mental health counseling, by an individual pre-approved by the Board, for a period of 1 year. **SLATER** must submit the name and contact information of her intended mental health therapist to the Board's investigation unit for written approval. The 1-year mandated mental health treatment period will not begin until **SLATER'S** mental health therapist is approved. **SLATER'S** mental health therapist is required to submit a report to the Board, quarterly, providing information discussed in therapy. At the end of the 1-year period, **SLATER'S** mental health therapist will make a final report encompassing the 1 year of therapy. If **SLATER'S** mental health therapist is concerned with **SLATER'S** ability to practice as a social worker at any time the Board should be notified immediately. It is **SLATER'S** responsibility to ensure that the Board receives the therapy reports. All costs associated with the therapy are at the expense of **SLATER**.

It is hereby agreed by and between both parties that this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** hereby settles all issues concerning this matter.

By her signature on this **CONSENT AGREEMENT**, **SLATER** acknowledges that in the event the **BOARD**, in its discretion, does not approve this **CONSENT AGREEMENT**, this settlement offer is withdrawn and shall be of no evidentiary value and shall not be relied upon or introduced in any disciplinary action or appeal by either party. **SLATER** agrees that should the **BOARD** reject this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** and if this case proceeds to hearing, she will assert no claim that the **BOARD** was prejudiced by its review and discussion of this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** or of any information relating thereto.

**SLATER** hereby releases the members of the **BOARD**, its officers and employees, jointly and severally, from any and all liability arising from the matter within.

**AMENDED CONSENT AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN  
JENNIFER SLATER  
AND THE  
STATE OF OHIO COUNSELOR, SOCIAL WORKER, MARRIAGE AND

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into by and between JENNIFER SLATER, hereinafter, "**SLATER**," and the STATE OF OHIO COUNSELOR, SOCIAL WORKER, MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPIST BOARD, hereinafter "**BOARD**," the state agency charged with enforcing Chapter 4757 of the Ohio Revised Code and all rules promulgated therein.

**SLATER** hereby acknowledges that she has read and understands this CONSENT AGREEMENT and has voluntarily entered into it without threat or promise by the **BOARD** or any of its members, employees or agents.

**SLATER** is fully aware of her rights, including her right to be advised by counsel and her right to a hearing pursuant to Chapter 119 of the Ohio Revised Code on the issues which are the subject of this CONSENT AGREEMENT. Should **SLATER** fail to comply with any provisions of this CONSENT AGREEMENT, **SLATER** knowingly waives her rights under ORC Chapter 119 to a hearing.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT contains the entire agreement between the parties, there being no other agreement of any kind, verbal or otherwise, which varies the terms of this CONSENT AGREEMENT.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into on the basis of the following stipulations, admissions and understandings:

1. **SLATER** is a social worker (S-0001381) licensed to practice social work in the State of Ohio, and is subject to the laws and rules of Ohio regulating the practice of social work as outlined in Ohio Revised Code Chapter 4757 and Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 4757. **SLATER** received her social work license on March 14, 1987.
2. In July 2007, **SLATER** entered into a Consent Agreement with the Board. As part of that Agreement, **SLATER** was to attend mandatory 12-step program and attend mandated mental health counseling through July 2008. In May 2008 was arrested on a parole violation and sentenced by the Ashland County Court of Common Pleas to complete

her original jail sentence.

3. **SLATER** admits the allegations referenced in paragraph 2 above.

Wherefore, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual promises hereinafter set forth, and in lieu of any other formal disciplinary proceedings, **SLATER** knowingly and voluntarily agrees with the **BOARD** to the following terms and conditions:

1. **SLATER'S** license to practice social work is hereby Suspended for one year beginning July 18, 2008 .
2. Once **SLATER** is released from custody, she must receive mental health counseling, by an individual pre-approved by the Board, for a period of one year. **SLATER** must submit the name and contact information of her intended mental health therapist to the Board's investigation unit for written approval. The one-year mandated mental health treatment period will not begin until after **SLATER'S** mental health therapist is approved. **SLATER'S** mental health therapist is required to submit a report to the Board, quarterly, providing information discussed in therapy. At the end of the 1-year period, **SLATER'S** therapist will make a final report encompassing the one-year of therapy. If Slater's therapist is concerned with her ability to practice as a social worker at anytime the Board should be immediately notified. It is **SLATER'S** responsibility to ensure that the Board receives the therapy reports. All costs, if any, with the therapy are at the expense of **SLATER**.
3. After **SLATER** is released from custody, she must attend a mandatory 12-Step program at least twice a month until July 2010. **SLATER** must notify the Board's investigation unit in writing of the name of the 12-Step program she will be attending within two weeks after her release from custody. **SLATER** must have the leader of the 12-Step program send in a quarterly statement to the Board's investigation unit verifying her attendance at the meetings.

It is hereby agreed by and between both parties that this CONSENT AGREEMENT hereby settles all issues concerning this matter.

By her signature on this CONSENT AGREEMENT, **SLATER** acknowledges that in the event the **BOARD**, in its discretion, does not approve this CONSENT AGREEMENT, this settlement offer is withdrawn and shall be of no evidentiary value and shall not be relied upon or introduced in any disciplinary action or appeal by either party. **SLATER** agrees that should the **BOARD** reject this CONSENT AGREEMENT and if this case proceeds to hearing, she will assert no claim that the **BOARD** was prejudiced by its

review and discussion of this CONSENT AGREEMENT or of any information relating thereto.

**SLATER** hereby releases the members of the **BOARD**, its officers and employees, jointly and severally, from any and all liability arising from the matter within.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT shall be considered a public record as that term is used in Section 149.43 of the Ohio Revised Code. Pursuant to 42 USC Section 132a-73(b), 5 USC Section 552a, 45 CFR part 61, and Ohio Revised Code Section 3123.41 et seq. the **BOARD** may be required to provide **SLATER'S** social security number to requesting governmental agencies.


