A Notice of Opportunity for Hearing was issued to Renza Hughley, Jr. on September 29, 1995. As Mr. Hughley did not request a hearing the Board issued the following order at their January 12, 1996 Board meeting.

Summary of Evidence

2. Copy of September 22, 1995 Board minutes directing Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to be sent to Mr. Hugley, Jr.
3. Copy of the Indictment and Journal Entry in the matter of Mr. Hughley, Jr., Trumbull County Court of Common Pleas.
4. July 21, 1995 Board minutes that sets forth Mr. Hughley's license as a Licensed Social Worker.
5. Copy of Mr. Hughley's application for social work license.

Conclusions of Law

- A. Pursuant to Revised Code 4757.13. The Counselor and Social worker Board may, in accordance with Chapter 119 of the Revised Code, refuse to issue or renew, or may suspend or revoke, any license or certificate of registration applied for or issued under this chapter and rules adopted under it if the person has;
 - (B) Knowingly made a false statement in his application for licensure or registration, or for renewal of his license or certificate of registration, under this chapter and rules adopted under it;

Order

THEREFORE, it is order adjudged, and decreed by the State of Ohio Counselor and Social Worker Board that;

Renza Hughley, Jr's license be suspended for one year. The suspension is Stayed and Mr. Hughley's license is put on probation for one year from the date of issuance of this final order.

The following as conditions to Mr. Hughley's probation:

1. Mr. Hughley may not practice drug counseling as his primary area of practice;
2. Quarterly reports to the Board verifying that practice setting does not primarily involve drug counseling and a job description. These reports shall come directly from Mr. Hughley's employer;
3. Quarterly reports shall be submitted to the Board within ten (10) days of each quarter, first report due May 10, 1996, last report due May 10, 1997. Based upon the satisfactory completion of probation and the Board's review of the last report, the Board will act to lift the suspension.
