

**CONSENT AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
DONNA WOLTZ-DYER
AND THE
STATE OF OHIO COUNSELOR, SOCIAL WORKER AND MARRIAGE AND
FAMILY THERAPIST BOARD**

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into by and between DONNA WOLTZ-DYER, hereinafter, "**WOLTZ-DYER,**" and the STATE OF OHIO COUNSELOR, SOCIAL WORKER AND MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPIST BOARD, hereinafter "**BOARD,**" the state agency charged with enforcing Chapter 4757 of the Ohio Revised Code and all rules promulgated therein.

WOLTZ-DYER hereby acknowledges that she has read and understands this CONSENT AGREEMENT and has voluntarily entered into it without threat or promise by the **BOARD** or any of its members, employees or agents.

WOLTZ-DYER is fully aware of her rights, including her right to be advised by counsel and her right to a hearing pursuant to Chapter 119 of the Ohio Revised Code on the issues which are the subject of this CONSENT AGREEMENT. Should **WOLTZ-DYER** fail to comply with any provisions of this CONSENT AGREEMENT, **WOLTZ-DYER** knowingly waives her rights under ORC Chapter 119 with respect to the claims in this agreement

This CONSENT AGREEMENT contains the entire agreement between the parties, there being no other agreement of any kind, verbal or otherwise, which varies the terms of this CONSENT AGREEMENT.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into on the basis of the following stipulations, admissions and understandings:

1. **WOLTZ-DYER** is a social worker (S-0028873) licensed in the State of Ohio, and is subject to the laws and rules of Ohio regulating the practice of social work as outlined in Ohio Revised Code Chapter 4757 and Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 4757. **WOLTZ-DYER** received her social work license on July 20, 2001.
2. **WOLTZ-DYER** was employed with Hardin County Job and Family Services, Kenton, Ohio. On or about November 24, 2003, **WOLTZ-DYER** completed an assessment of her own home to be licensed as a foster parent, at the request of her agency, creating a conflict of interest. This inappropriate conduct constitutes a violation of Ohio Revised Code Section 4757.36(A)(1) and Ohio Administrative Code Section 4757-5-01(C)(2).
3. **WOLTZ-DYER**, while employed with Hardin County Job and Family

Services, failed to keep accurate records, due to technical difficulties, to reflect the services provided and failed to include sufficient and timely documentation in records to facilitate the delivery of services and to ensure continuity of services provided to clients in the future. This conduct constitutes a violation of Ohio Revised Code Section 4757.36(A)(1) and Ohio Administrative Code Section 4757-5-01(I) (1) and (2).

4. **WOLTZ-DYER ADMITS** the allegations referenced in paragraphs 2 and 3 above.

Wherefore, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual promises hereinafter set forth, and in lieu of any formal disciplinary proceedings, **WOLTZ-DYER** knowingly and voluntarily agrees with the **BOARD** to the following terms and conditions:

1. **WOLTZ-DYER** is required to complete ten (10) hours of continuing education in social work ethics, at her expense. These hours are in addition to the thirty (30) hours required for renewal of her SW license and will not count towards that renewal. The continuing education hours must be pre-approved by the Board. **WOLTZ-DYER** must contact the Board's investigative unit to seek pre-approval. **WOLTZ-DYER** must complete the continuing education hours by July 2006.

It is hereby agreed by and between both parties that this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** hereby settles all issues concerning this matter.

By her signature on this **CONSENT AGREEMENT**, **WOLTZ-DYER** acknowledges that in the event the **BOARD**, in its discretion, does not approve this **CONSENT AGREEMENT**, this settlement offer is withdrawn and shall be of no evidentiary value and shall not be relied upon or introduced in any disciplinary action or appeal by either party. **WOLTZ-DYER** agrees that should the **BOARD** reject this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** and if this case proceeds to hearing, she will assert no claim that the **BOARD** was prejudiced by its review and discussion of this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** or of any information relating thereto.

WOLTZ-DYER hereby releases the members of the **BOARD**, its officers and employees, jointly and severally, from any and all liability arising from the matter within.

This **CONSENT AGREEMENT** shall be considered a public record as that term is used in Section 149.43 of the Ohio Revised Code. Pursuant to 42 USC Section 132a-73(b), 5 USC Section 552a, 45 CFR part 61 and Ohio Revised Code Section 2301.373(E), the **BOARD** may be required to provide **WOLTZ-DYER'S** social security number to requesting governmental agencies.

The **BOARD** shall incorporate this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** into a formal journal entry at its September 30, 2005, meeting.




