Updates

Ohio AMFT Honors CSWMFT Staff

Bill Hegarty, Tammy Tingle, and Tracey Hosom were honored for their dedication and hard work by the OAMFT in April. All three have copies of the award posted in their workspace if you'd like to see how the kind recognition the OAMFT bestowed upon them.

Medicaid

I will be meeting with Ohio Department of Medicaid staff on May 17th to discuss concerns that have been expressed regarding the Behavioral Health Redesign. I hope to have information to share regarding any impacts on the Board's licensees.

ASWB Spring Education Meeting

ASWB will be announcing additional exam policy decisions. The ASWB Board has decided to follow the exam policy as established. This may mean Ohio will have to seek an exemption for its policy that allows students to take the exam before graduating. Additionally, and more challenging, will be the likely requirement that MSW graduates take the ASWB MSW exam for licensure. The meeting focused on license mobility/portability. While there seems to be great interest in the concept, it is clear we will need to have more in-depth discussions to find ways to eliminate barriers. I was notified by ASWB staff and Board members that a letter I wrote regarding the amount of our membership fees has been the focus of a couple of discussions. I am not sure we will see a reduction, but future increases may be limited.

Board Audit – State Auditor of Ohio

The State Auditor has been gathering documents and asking questions. We expect the auditors to return shortly after the end of the FY in June.

NBCC State Administrators' Meeting

Ryan Pickut and I will be attending the NBCC State Administrators' meeting at the end of May. Many Counselor educators have questions about the exam results that we hope to have answered.

eLicense 3.0

A change in the management of the development of the new licensing system has been announced. CSWMFT will still be actively involved in helping to guide the project, but it will be in a different capacity. No change in the schedule is proposed. We are still scheduled to implement the system in the second half of CY 2017.
