The Marriage and Family Therapist Professional Standards Committee (MFTPSC) meeting was called to order by Ms. Barson, at approximately 9 a.m. on July 21, 2006. The meeting took place at the offices of the Counselor, Social Worker and Marriage & Family Therapist Board, and took place over two business days. . The meeting was adjourned at approximately 12:00 p.m. on July 22, 2006.

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**1. Discussion of Agenda:**

- a. A motion was made by Mrs. Sharkey Dirck to approve the agenda, seconded by Mr. Trivison; motion passes.

**2. New Business**

- a. Election of a New Committee Chair:
  - i. Ms. Barson will not be seeking reappointment as a Board member. Her term expires in October 2006.
    - 1. Ms. Sharkey Dirck moved to nominate Mr. Trivison to serve as MFTPSC Chair. The motion was seconded by Mr. Camerino; motion passed.
      - a. Mr. Trivison accepted the nomination, and will begin to serve as MFTPSC Chair at the September 2006 meeting.
  - ii. The MFTPSC wished Ms. Barson well, and wished her luck in her new endeavors.
- b. Election of a New Personnel Committee Member:
  - i. Ms. Barson, in addition to her responsibilities as the MFTPSC Chair, was also a member of the Personnel Committee. The Personnel Committee is charged with reviewing the performance of the Board's Executive Director, and is comprised of three members of the Social Work Professional Standards Committee (SWPSC) and the Counselor Professional Standards Committee (CPSC). In addition the Chairperson of the Board sits on the Personnel Committee.
    - 1. Mr. Camerino offered to sit on the Personnel Committee.
      - a. Ms. Barson moved that the MFTPSC elect Mr. Camerino to the Personnel Committee. The motion was seconded by Mr. Trivison; motion passed.
- c. A motion was made by Mr. Trivison to license three applicants for the IMFT credential, and three for the MFT credential. Seconded by Mr. Camerino. The names of those licensed on July 21, 2006 are listed below:

- d. The MFTPSC approved 5 applicants to sit for the Marital and Family Examination, and tabled one application until September; pending additional information.
- e. The MFTPSC noted that the number one item on the agenda for the September MFTPSC meeting will be setting a clear date that the proposed supervision rules, as outlined in Board Rule 4757-29-01, go into effect.
- f. The MFTPSC entered into executive session on May 19, 2006 at 11:30 am to discuss legislative and staffing issues.
  - i. Voting Aye: Mr. Camerino, Mrs. Sharkey Dirck, and Mr. Trivison
  - ii. The MFTPSC came out of executive session on May 19, 2006 at 11:45 a.m.

### **3. Directors Report to the Committee**

- a. Mr. Rough, Executive Director; informed the MFTPSC of the results of the Auditor of State's recent audit of the CSWMFT Board. There was nothing substantial to report.
- b. Discussed with the Committee about the documentation of dual relationships.
- c. Mr. Rough and Mr. Powrie informed the MFTPSC about the lack of a supervision rule for Marriage and Family Therapists.
  - i. No supervision rule currently exists, because this rule was delayed in going forward when the Board pulled the proposed rules at a Joint Commission on Agency Rule Review (JCARR) meeting.
  - ii. Mr. Rough would like the MFTPSC to review proposed Board Rule 4757-29-01, which is the MFT Supervision rule, and give him the authority to go forward with the rule adoption process.
    1. Mr. Trivison moved that the Executive Director begin the rule adoption process. The motion was seconded by Mr. Camerino. The motion carried.

### **4. Deputy Director's Report to the Committee**

- a. Informed the Committee that there has been no reported complaints regarding MFT's since the last Board meeting

### **5. Legislative Update:**

- a. The MFTPSC believes that the priority in the proposed "clean-up bill" should be the ability of Marriage and Family Therapists to diagnose mental and emotional disorders.

### **6. Meeting Adjourned**

- a. A motion was made by Mr. Trivison to adjourn the MFTPSC on July 21, 2006 at 12:00 pm. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Sharkey Dirck; motion passes
