1. **Meeting Called to Order**

Dr. McGloshen re-convened the meeting at 9:17 a.m.

2. **Discussion Issues**

New Business

- The Committee voted to propose re-election of Mr. Robertson for full Board chair and voted Dr. McGloshen as chair of the MFTPSC.

MFT License

- The Committee discussed the requirements for endorsement of out of state licensure. Each application is reviewed on a case-by-case basis but the Committee agreed that

there are general criteria taken into consideration, such as comparable requirements between states, length of time licensed, any AAMFT distinctions, etc.

- The Committee reviewed the draft rule creating an IMFT supervisory designation. Ms. McCloud moved to accept the proposed rule with amended sections. Dr. Petrich seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- While reviewing applications for licensure, a question was raised regarding expunged and sealed records. Clarification was sought as to whether someone must disclose these convictions. The Committee was advised that public protection policy states applicants need to disclose criminal records even if those records are expunged.

3. Director's Report to the Committee

Mr. Rough, Executive Director, gave his report to the MFTPSC.

- Mr. Rough discussed all current legislation relevant to the Board. House Bill 567 has been introduced by Rep. Sears on behalf of the Board.
- Mr. Rough welcomed our newest member to the Board and also the MFTPSC, Ms. Stephanie McCloud. Ms. McCloud fulfills the public member role for the MFTPSC. The Board is still awaiting appointments for several positions, including one other position on this committee (an MFT licensee).
- The Board's budget ended fiscal year 2012 in excellent shape due to increased savings in several areas of operation.
- The five year rule review changes were not filed as planned in May but should be filed shortly after the conclusion of this month's board meeting.

4. Working Meeting

The MFTPSC proceeded with a working meeting to review CEU Programs and Providers.
