The Marriage and Family Therapist Professional Standards Committee (MFTPSC) meeting was called to order by Mr. Trivison, at approximately 9 a.m. on September 21, 2006. The meeting took place at the offices of the Counselor, Social Worker and Marriage & Family Therapist Board, and took place over two business days. The meeting was adjourned at approximately 11 a.m. on September 22, 2006.

1. Discussion of Agenda:

- a. A motion was made by Mrs. Sharkey Dirck to approve the agenda, seconded by Mr. Trivison; motion passes.

2. New Business

- a. The committee edited the proposed MFT supervision rules (Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 4757-29-01) that will go before a public meeting on September 22, 2006.
 - i. Ms. Barson moved to approve proposed Board rule (OAC 4757-29-01) as amended; and will allow the rule to be presented a public hearing on September 22, 2006.
 - 1. The motion was seconded by Ms. Sharkey Dirck; the motion carries.
- b. The committee reviewed Board Rule 4757-03-01(J)(1)
 - i. A motion was made by Mr. Camerino to allow applicants with a graduate level Marriage and Family Therapist coursework, with a grade at or above a “B-“ be eligible for licensure.
 - ii. The motion was seconded by Ms. Sharkey Dirck; the motion carries.
- c. A motion was made by Mr. Trivison to license one applicant for the IMFT credential, and one for the MFT credential. Seconded by Mr. Camerino. The names of those licensed on September 22, 2006 are listed below:

3. Directors Report to the Committee

- a. Discussed the recent relocation to the Board’s new office
- b. The Executive Director informed the committee about the five year rule review that will take place over the next year
 - i. The Executive Director would like feedback from all of the professional committees regarding the rule review.
- c. The MFTPSC recommended to the Executive Director that the Board become more involved with consume awareness, and raised several suggestions about how to accomplish that goal

4. Deputy Director’s Report to the Committee

- a. Informed the Committee that there has been one case involving a MFT since July 2006. After investigating the allegations, the Deputy Director recommended that the MFTPSC close the case with a strong cautionary letter.
 - i. A motion was made by Mr. Trivison to close case number 2006-117. Seconded by Ms. Barson; the motion carries.

- a. A motion was made by Mr. Trivison to adjourn the MFTPSC on September 22, 2006 at 10:50 am. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Sharkey Dirck; motion passes
