## CONSENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN TERESA S. GATTON AND THE

## STATE OF OHIO COUNSELOR, SOCIAL WORKER, MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPIST BOARD

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into by and between TERESA S. GATTON, hereinafter, "GATTON", and the STATE OF OHIO COUNSELOR, SOCIAL WORKER, MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPIST BOARD, hereinafter "BOARD", the state agency charged with enforcing Chapter 4757 of the Ohio Revised Code and all rules promulgated thereunder.

**GATTON** hereby acknowledges that she has read and understands this CONSENT AGREEMENT and has voluntarily entered into it without threat or promise by the **BOARD** or any of its members, employees or agents.

GATTON is fully aware of her rights, including her right to be advised by counsel and her right to a hearing pursuant to Chapter 119 of the Ohio Revised Code on the issues which are the subject of this CONSENT AGREEMENT. Should GATTON fail to comply with any provisions of this CONSENT AGREEMENT, GATTON knowingly waives her rights under ORC Chapter 119.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT contains the entire agreement between the parties, there being no other agreement of any kind, verbal or otherwise, which varies the terms of this CONSENT AGREEMENT.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into on the basis of the following stipulations, admissions and understandings:

- GATTON is an independent social worker (I-458) licensed to practice social work in the State of Ohio, and is subject to the laws and rules of Ohio regulating the practice of social work as outlined in Ohio Revised Code Chapter 4757 and Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 4757. GATTON received her independent social work license on April 5, 1986.
- 2. While **GATTON** was employed at North Central Mental Health Services, Columbus, Ohio, she breeched her professional social work boundaries by allowing a client to come to her home on several weekends. **GATTON'S** actions constitute a violation of Ohio Revised Code Section 4757.36(A)(1) and Ohio Administrative Code Section 4757-5-01(C).
- 3. GATTON ADMITS the allegations referenced in paragraph 2 above.

Wherefore, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual promises hereinafter set forth, and in lieu of any formal disciplinary proceedings, GATTON knowingly and voluntarily agrees with BOARD to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. GATTON'S license to practice counseling is hereby REFRIMANDED.
- 2. GATTON must receive face-to-face supervision, by an individual preapproved by the Board, one-hour every week for a period of 2 years. GATTON should not select a supervisor with which she has a prior relationship. If any previous relationship with the supervisor exists, GATTON must provide full disclosure of such a relationship in the request for supervisor approval. GATTON'S request for supervisor approval must be in writing and must be received no later than January 30, 2004. The 2-year supervision period will not begin until GATTON'S supervisor is approved. Supervision should focus on, but not limited to, GATTON'S role in professional relationships, ethical decision-making and maintaining appropriate boundaries. For the first year of the two-year required supervision, GATTON'S supervisor is required to submit a report to the Board, quarterly detailing topics discussed during supervision sessions, areas of concern, and areas of improvement. During the second year of supervision, GATTON'S supervisor will submit a report at the 6-month mark and a final report at the end of the 2-year supervision period. If GATTON'S supervisor is concerned with GATTON'S practice at any time the Board should be notified immediately. It is GATTON'S responsibility to ensure that the Board receives the supervisor's reports. All costs associated with supervision are at the expense of GATTON.

It is hereby agreed by and between both parties that this CONSENT AGREEMENT hereby settles all issues concerning this matter.

By her signature on this CONSENT AGREEMENT, GATTON acknowledges that in the event the BOARD, in its discretion, does not approve this CONSENT AGREEMENT, this settlement offer is withdrawn and shall be of no evidentiary value and shall not be relied upon or introduced in any disciplinary action or appeal by either party. GATTON agrees that should the BOARD reject this CONSENT AGREEMENT and if this case proceeds to hearing, she will assert no claim that the BOARD was prejudiced by its review and discussion of this CONSENT AGREEMENT or of any information relating thereto.

**GATTON** hereby releases the members of the **BOARD**, its officers and employees, jointly and severally, from any and all liability arising from the matter within.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT shall be considered a public record as that term is used in Section 149.43 of the Ohio Revised Code. Pursuant to 42 USC Section 132a-73(b), 5 USC Section 552a, 45 CFR part 61, and Ohio Revised Code 3123.41 et seq the **BOARD** may be required to provide **GATTON'S** social security number to requesting governmental agencies.
