This matter came for consideration after a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing was issued to Yolanda Bailey by the Counselor, Social Worker, and Marriage and Family Therapist Board on September 18, 2017. An administrative hearing was held on March 2, 2018, at 11:30 a.m. in the offices of the Ohio Counselor, Social Worker, and Marriage and Family Therapist Board, 77 S. High Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215, pursuant to Chapter 119 and Section 4757 of the Ohio Revised Code. The State was represented by Senior Assistant Attorney Melissa L. Wilburn. Yolanda Bailey was not present and was not represented by counsel.

### **DISCUSSION**

The Social Worker Professional Committee hearing the case reviewed all the Hearing Officer's Report and Recommendations and exhibits. Ms. Bailey did submit objections to the Hearing Officer's Report and Recommendations were also reviewed by the Committee.

The Board noted that since the date of the hearing and the review by the Social Worker Professional Standards Committee, Ms. Bailey submitted proof that she has completed the required 30 hours of continuing education to renew her social work license. The Committee noted that Ms. Bailey had plenty of opportunity to submit these hours during the audit process and prior to the date of the administrative hearing.

### **FINDINGS, ORDER, AND JOURNAL ENTRY**

THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that for the reasons outlined in this Adjudication Order, The Committee modifies the recommendation of the Hearing Officer and the social work license (S.0900633) of Yolanda Bailey is **Reprimanded**.

This Order was approved by a majority vote of the Social Work Professional Standards Committee members who reviewed this case at hearing.

It is hereby certified by this Board that the above language is incorporated into the Board's journal in this matter.

### **APPEAL RIGHTS**

Ohio Revised Code Section 119.12 may authorize an appeal from this Order. Such an appeal must be commenced by the filing of a Notice of Appeal with the Ohio Counselor, Social Worker, and Marriage and Family Therapist Board and in the court of common pleas of the county in which the licensee is a resident. If the party appealing from the order is not a resident of any County, the party may appeal to the court of common pleas of Franklin County. The Notice of Appeal must set forth the order appealed from and state that the agency's order is not supported by reliable, probative, and substantial evidence and is not in accordance with the law. The Notice of Appeal may, but need not, set forth the specific grounds of the party's appeal beyond the statement that the agency's order is not supported by reliable, probative, and substantial evidence and is not in accordance with law. Both Notices of Appeal must be received at the office of the Board and filed with the applicable court within fifteen (15) days after mailing of this notice of

the agency's order, and in accordance with the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Chapter 119.12.
